In an effort to begin a dialogue around these issues, the DLIA has invited representatives of the Town of Delavan and the Delavan Lake Sanitary District (DLSD) to meet with concerned and interested property owners in order to begin an exchange of ideas about these views and possibly begin to form possible solutions.

As we would all agree, these issues are complicated, and solutions may require the involvement of more parties beyond the Town and the DLSD. We would expect that questions from owners about other topics in addition to water levels and quality.

The DLIA will host this round table discussion on May 25th at 4pm in the Town of Delavan's new community center, Waters Edge.
